## North Eastern Region Community Resource Management Society (NERCRMS)-Terms of Reference (ToR ) for Selection of Partner NGOs:

- 1. NGOs/ Societies/Trusts should be a registered body. With proper maintenance of accounting records and last 3 (three) years Chartered Accountant audit report and annual reports.
- 2. NGOs/ Societies/ Trusts should be having NGO Darpan Unique ID and registration certificate, PAN card, Bank account (in nationalised bank), etc.
- 3. Preferably the NGOs/ Societies/ Trusts should have Public Financial Management System (PFMS) registration.
- 4. Preferably 5 (five) years of working experience in the relevant fields.
- 5. Having experience in community development, formation of CBOs and capacity buildings.
- 6. Having ability to demonstrate an openness to learn and absorb new strategies and ideas.
- 7. Having an office base in the project areas, understanding of the socio-economic, culture and political situation of the project areas.
- 8. A proven record of successful intermediation services, mobilizing communities for group action, able to network with other stakeholders in a team spirit and should be adjustable to varied operation modalities.
- 9. A non-political and secular organization with no affiliation to political parties (especially among the executives).
- 10. Preference shall be given to local NGOs/Societies/Trusts working within the targeted project District. They should be willing to work in interior areas and accustomed with the local languages.
- 11. The NGO should be willing to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the programme implementing agency i.e. NERCRMS committing itself:
  - a) To pursue the objectives of the project.
  - b) NGO should be flexible enough to modify its strategy and systems according to the need of the project.
  - c) To attend meetings and to contribute to the feedbacks systems and procedures required by the implementing programme agency.
- 12. The signing of the MoU is a precondition to enter in the contract with NERCRMS for the project outlining its role and function.
